

## Information about the feedback discussion

A feedback discussion about the doctoral project pursuant to § 15 passage 7 of the statutory regulations of the TUM Graduate School normally takes place within 24 months after the entry into the TUM-GS (preliminary membership). This discussion in which the continuation of the doctoral process is talked about is based on §13 passage 7 of the FGC-BGU order.

### Requirements for the discussion are:

- A seminar presentation within the public of the university, which can be replaced by a presentation during a scientific congress,
- A written interim report by the doctoral candidate about the progress of the scientific work, which can be replaced by a scientific article handed in for publication if this article also contains all the results,
- a two-page fact-sheet (pursuant to the format specifications by the department) that is appropriate for the public announcement of the doctoral project (i. g. on the Website of the FGC-BGU),
- an updated supervision agreement  
and
- an advisory discussion with the mentor
